One way closure of Macdougall Street from Faulks Terrace to Ardmore Street. Traffic to flow as usual out of town.	Sunday 22 February from 0900 to 1730	To allow safe passage of athletes travelling at high speed down the hill	Via Faulks Terrace and Meadowstone or Golf Course Road. Access to the Motor Camp will be provided through a traffic control point on the Brownston/Macdougall Streets junction
Helwick Street from Dunmore Street to Ardmore Street	Saturday 21 February from 0300 to Sunday 22 February at 0300	Create a pedestrianised family zone with entertainment, food and shopping	Via Dunmore Street, Dungarvon and Brownsont Streets
One way closure of Red Bridge (northbound)	Sunday 22 February from 0830 to 1700	Challenge Wanaka to prevent long traffic delays to northbound traffic (a detour will be quicker)	Via Camphill Road, Hawea Flat and Kane Road

Changes to road closures approved in previous years is the one way closure of Macdougall Street from Faulks Terrace. This is proposed in the best interest of public safety. Cyclists travel down the the hill at up to 75kph, far exceeding the speed limit. Despite there being marshalls on every side road junction, with the annual increase in the number of cyclists it would be a lot safer to close the road, less stressful for the volunteers. The closure of the road will also eliminte the problem area at the bottom of Macdougall Street where cyclists have to cross the path of vehicles to turn right into transition, again improving safety and reducing stress on volunteers. All streets other than the holiday park can be accessed by alternative routes. Access to the holiday park will be managed via traffic control across Macdougall Street from Brownston Street.
