Note: the Beach Street intersection will be opened and manned by Southern Safety Services between 2130 and 0030.

It will be an offence under the above regulations for any person otherwise than under authority of an authorised permit to use the roads for ordinary vehicular traffic during the period of closure.

Goat Control Operation

Queenstown Lakes District Council has employed the services of professional contractors to carry out a goat control operation from Monday 17 June 2019. Work will continue for approximately one month from this date (weather dependent). The aim of the operation is to attempt to reduce the likelihood of goats becoming a hazard to vehicles, and causing further nuisance to residents' properties.

The operation will target the following areas:

- Matakauri Park, Gorge Road
- Area above Boydtown, Huff and Fryer Streets
- Area above Greenstone Place, Scott Place and Caples Place, Fernhill

This operation will involve ground hunting, and contractors will be clearly visible. Any public walking tracks in reserves where work is being carried out will be closed, and signage and personnel will be in place during closure periods.
