## Closure of Streets to Ordinary Vehicular Traffic

**PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1974**, notice is hereby given that consideration will be given by Queenstown Lakes District Council under delegated authority, to the closure of the following roads to ordinary vehicular traffic for the purpose of holding the **2019 Pioneer event**:

**Road to be Closed:** Moke Lake Road, Closeburn (between Alpine Retreat Rd and Moke Lake)

**Period of Closure:** Sunday, 1 December 2019 from 8.30am to 2.30pm

**Road to be Closed:** Nairn Street, Arrowtown (between Bedford Street and Ford Street)

**Period of Closure:** Monday, 2 December 2019 from 10.00am to 5.00pm

It will be an offence under the above regulations for any person otherwise than under authority of an authorised permit to use the roads for ordinary vehicular traffic during the period of closure.
