1. Kawarau Jet Services Holdings Limited (RM181023)

What is proposed:

Land use consent is sought for:

- a) The use of the surface of water and the use of parts of the foreshore of Lake Wakatipu and the Kawarau River for a scheduled ferry service and charter operations for people to travel between Queenstown and various other locations adjacent to the lake and river;
- The construction and use of a jetty.

The location in respect of which this application relates is situated at: The part of the surface of the Lake Wakatipu comprising:

- Queenstown Bay;
- The Narrows;
- Frankton Arm.

The surface of the Kawarau River, from the outlet at Kawarau Falls (at the eastern end of Frankton Arm) to the Hayes Creek confluence;

Parts of the margins of the lake and river, for the purpose of short term stops at existing and future jetties and landings including, where applicable, shorelines, whether or not artificially formed into landing platforms or other landing devices, as follows:

- (i) Existing facilities:
- Wharf at the Main Town Pier in Queenstown Bay
- The jetty at the foreshore reserve adjacent to Bay View Road, Kelvin Heights:
- The public wharf at the Frankton Marina;
- The jetty at the foreshore reserve adjacent to Boyes Crescent, Frankton
- The jetty adjacent to the Hilton Hotel at Kawarau Falls Station;

(ii) A new jetty located on the bank and bed of the Kawarau River, on the true left side, adjacent to the Bridesdale Farm, Lake Hayes Estate. This proposed jetty is at the location of the former HeliJet jetty (of which there still remains on the river bank).
