

## **Notice of Intention to Grant Easements Over Recreation** Reserves

SKYLINE ENTERPRISES LIMITED & AURORA ENERGY LIMITED PURSUANT TO SECTION 48 OF THE RESERVES ACT 1977

The land described in Schedule A of this Notice is vested in the Queenstown Lakes District Council pursuant to Section 26A of the Reserves Act 1977 as Recreation Reserves. Skyline Enterprises Limited are seeking a series of easements over the reserves for the following reasons:

- Right of Support for the establishment of rock anchors beyond the site boundary in favour a)
- Fight of Support for the establishment of rock anchors beyond the site boundary in favour of Section1 SO 22971& Area A (Car Park Lease);

  Right of Support and Rock Fall Prevention Measures for the bluffs 18, 19 and 20 in favour of Section 1 SO 22971& Area A (Car Park Lease);

  Right of Way in favour of Section 1 SO 22971& Area A (Car Park Lease); b)
- Right to Convey Electricity in Gross for Aurora Energy Limited. d)

The Council is considering granting the easements pursuant to Section 48 of the Reserves Act 1977, providing that consideration of Easement Area D is to be first subject to Council agreeing to a traffic assessment that provides solutions to delineate public use of the Brecon Street to Hamilton Road connection, and Skyline pedestrian use between the base building and the car parking building. The objective shall be to ensure shared use of the area and no conflicts between users, with the primary The considering being public use of the area. Also that any landscaping/planting to delineate the Skyline Enterprises Ltd lease area, is to occur within that lease area, and not in the easement area.

Pursuant to Section 48 of the Reserves Act 1977 the Council has an obligation to publicly notify its intention to grant such easements by way of this Notice.

## What is proposed:

The applicant proposes to construct a new access off the southern side of the Glenorchy Queenstown Road and establish a safe viewing area including toilet facilities to replace an existing informal carpark near Bennett's Bluff lookout. The activity includes temporary construction activities, vegetation clearance, earthworks and stormwater management. The activity also provides for long-term traffic safety (including traffic signage), stormwater management and planting associated with the carpark area. The project seeks to provide safe access for road users to exceptional views over the lake and opportunity for knowledge of the cultural narrative of this area.
